### Introduction

Welcome, English learners! This worksheet will help you understand how to build simple and correct English sentences. Every sentence needs two main parts: a subject and a verb.

- **Subject:** Who or what the sentence is about.
- **Verb:** The action the subject is doing or what the subject is.

For example:

- She reads. (She = subject, reads = verb)
- The dog is happy. (The dog = subject, is = verb)
